Declaration of consent for the pre-check for participation in the program "Global Entry"



A successful registration in the Global Entry program of the American Authority Customs and Border Protection (CBP) requires a so called border police pre-check for German citizens. This is carried out by the Federal Police and needs my written consent.

- My application in the Global Entry program is voluntary.
- I am aware that the personal data from my travel document (passport) is compared to national and international databases.
- I hereby agree that in case of a successful pre-check the following information are transmitted to CBP: Surname, first name and date of birth. There is no further data storage or other use of the data intended. The transmission of the data is carried out encrypted and the information is used to inform CBP only.
- After the data transmission, I am able to apply for a participation in Global Entry (eg via the web portal https://www.cbp.gov/travel/trusted-traveler-programs/global-entry/how-apply).
- A successful pre-check does not automatically lead to the permission to participate at Global Entry. This is checked by CBP separately.
- After two years of membership in Global Entry, it will be necessary to perform an update off the pre-check by the Federal Police in order to continue the participation. This needs to take place within the third year of membership.
